



SANDRA BIRMAN is a Brazilian visual artist of Polish origin whose work explores the intersections between cultural roots and personal experiences. Her research explores fragmented memories, identity and landscape, using tapestries, textiles and painting. In her most recent works, the artist recreates landscapes based on 'Gobelin' tapestries and fabrics, reinterpreting idealized scenes from Europe that have marked generations and become iconic in Latin cultures. By appropriating and painting these images, the artist fragments and superimposes them in ornate compositions, transforming collective memories into an intimate and affective visual space.

With a degree in Visual Communication from PUC (Rio de Janeiro, Brazil) and a postgraduate degree in Art Curation from NOVA FCSH (Lisbon, Portugal). She is currently pursuing a master's degree in Curatorial Studies at the University of Coimbra.

Birman has participated in art exhibitions in Portugal, Brazil and the United Kingdom, most notably the 'RA Summer Exhibition' at the Royal Academy of Arts, in London (2022 and 2024). In 2024, she held her first solo exhibition 'Escape', at Gallery Castra Leuca Contemporary Art, in Castelo Branco, Portugal. In 2025, she participated in group exhibitions, most recently at the FEMA gallery in Cascais, and also at Corrente de Arte in the Mitra Pavilions in Lisbon, among others in Portugal. In Madrid, the artist exhibited her works at the JUSTMAD International Contemporary Art Fair. Sandra also works as an art curator for several solo and group exhibitions in Portugal. She currently lives and works between Lisbon, Portugal, and Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
